Mashook Mujib Chowdhury from the Sustainability department of DBL Group, Bangladesh, was selected by the UN Global Compact as one of the 2019 SDG Pioneers for the empowerment of working women.

After being selected as the 2019 Global Compact Network Bangladesh SDG Pioneer in May 2019 by the Global Compact Network Bangladesh (GCNB), he was automatically included to compete in the 2019 SDG Pioneers Global Round hosted by the UN Global Compact.
